AT THE CONTROLS

SBRA is pleased to sponsor "At the Controls: The Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum Looks at Cockpits," an exhibit at the Northern Indiana Center for History, June 11 through August 7. The exhibit features large-format color photographs of cockpits from airplanes and spacecraft in the world-renowned collection of the Smithsonian's National Air and Space Museum. Among the aircraft represented are the Wright Brothers 1903 Flyer, Ryan NYP Spirit of St. Louis, Grumman F4F-4 Wildcat, Supermarine Spitfire HF Mark VII and the Space Shuttle Columbia.

Special "Days of Flight" are scheduled for July 19 and August 5.
